



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# REĆ UREDNIKA

## 20 GODINA SALONA STRIPA

Srećna galerija Studentskog kulturnog centra Beograd već 20 godina organizuje i vodi Međunarodni salon stripa kao svoj redovni i najveći programski projekt. Strategija ove redakcije, zamišljena 2001. godine, bila je da se krene sa revitalizacijom stripa kao devete umetnosti u najpotpunijem obimu i da se ta umetnička disciplina u redovnom godišnjem programu eksplicira i predstavi publici u svim vidovima i segmentima njene pojavnosti. Imajući u vidu karakter programa redakcije, prevashodno vezan za likovnu umetnost, na početku se tematika vezana za strip orijentiše ka izložbenim konцепцијama iza kojih će, vrlo brzo i nužno, uslediti govorni programi tribina i predavanja te promocije autora i strip izdavaštva.

U januaru mesecu 2001. godine organizuje se *Fanzinijada*, veliki festival alternativnog, andergraund i autorskog stripa koja biva preteča Salona stripa, da bi se ubrzo stekli uslovi da Srećna galerija oformi i edukativne programe radionica za alternativne i klasične crtačke izraze i školu stripa za najmlađe polaznike.

Tada, usamljeni na domaćoj kulturnoj sceni, ali ipak ohrabreni velikim odzivom umetnika i interesenata za ovako koncipiran program, u septembru 2003. godine pokrećemo Međunarodni salon stripa mlađih, temeljno ispitujući preduslove za realizaciju zamišljenog velikog festivala koji će, kako sada vidimo, od svojih narednih izdanja postati najveći i najma-

sovniji strip događaj u ovom delu Evrope, profilisan za autore svih uzrasta iz svih zemalja sveta.

Međunarodni salon stripa SKC Beograd u proteklih 20 godina predstavio je beogradskoj publici više od 80 najeminentnijih strip autora iz sveta, Srbije i okruženja, a u svom takmičarskom delu programa oko 2.500 strip autora iz 60 zemalja sveta, od kojih je njih 1.000 iz kategorije uzrasta do 15. godina.

Bez obzira na uvažavajuću činjenicu da je strip pre svega književno delo, specifičnost ovog festivala ipak ostaje izlagачki segment strip stvaralaštva i eksplikacija najvirtuoznijih ostvarenja u domenu postignute likovnosti u stripu. Između ostalog, Salon svih ovih godina biva konceptualni zasnovan i na revalorizaciji domaćeg strip stvaralaštva, afirmaciji mlađih autora i domaćeg strip izdavaštva.

Dvadeseto jubilarno izdanje festivala u svom programu donosi dva reprezentativna umetnička projekta. Prvi, realizovan u saradnji sa ambasadom Kraljevine Španije u Beogradu, kroz dve reprezentativne izložbe i programe prezentacija, donosi projekat devet mlađih španskih autorki avangardnog stripa pod nazivom *Grafičko sazvežđe*. Drugi grandiozni projekat, u takođe dve izložbe, pod nazivom *Izvan kvadrata - pogled na umetničke rade strip skih autora iz Srbije*, koji okuplja 27 najeminentnijih srpskih strip autora, delo je strip skog kritičara i istoričara Živojina Tamburića iz Londona i srpskog stip teoretičara, scenariste i urednika Marka Stojanovića.

# EDITOR'S WORD

## 20th ANNIVERSARY OF THE COMICS FESTIVAL

For the past 20 years, the *Happy Gallery* of the Student Cultural Center in Belgrade has been organising and leading the International Comics Festival, as its regular and largest program. The editorial team's strategy, conceived in 2001, aimed to revitalise comics as the ninth art in its fullest form and present this artistic discipline to the audience in all its aspects within its annual program. Bearing in mind the editorial program, primarily related to visual arts, initially the emphasis was on the exhibition concepts related to comics. Subsequently, panel discussions, lectures, albums and publishers' promotions were introduced.

In January 2001, the *Fanzinijada* (Fanzinics), a major festival of alternative, underground, and authorial comics, was organised as a precursor to the comics festival. Soon after, the *Happy Gallery* established educational workshops for alternative and classical drawing expressions and a comics school for young participants.

At that time, although isolated on the domestic cultural scene, we were encouraged by the enthusiastic response from artists and interested parties for such a concept. In September 2003, after a thorough examination of the prerequisites for realising this envisioned grand festival, we launched the International Comics Festival for Youngs. It has since become the largest and most massive comics event

in this part of Europe, showcasing authors of all ages from around the world.

Over the past 20 years, the International Comics Festival at the Student Cultural Center in Belgrade has presented more than 80 prominent comic authors to the Belgrade audience from around the world, Serbia, and the surrounding region. The festival's competitive program section has featured around 2,500 comic authors from 60 countries, including 1,000 authors aged 15 and under.

While acknowledging comics as primarily literary works, the distinctiveness of this festival lies in its exhibition segment of comics art and the presentation of the most virtuosic achievements in the visual arts domain. The festival is conceptually based on the reevaluation of domestic comics creation, the promotion of young authors and the domestic publishing industry.

The 20th-anniversary edition of the festival presents two representative artistic projects. The first, realised in collaboration with the Embassy of the Kingdom of Spain in Belgrade, is the *Graphic Constellation* project featuring nine young Spanish avant-garde female comics authors through two exhibitions and presentation programs. The second project, titled *Beyond Comics - A Look into the Artwork of Serbian Comics Artists*, is a grandiose endeavour consisting of two exhibitions. It showcases the works of 27 eminent Serbian artists and is the result of collaboration between Živojin Tamburić, a comics critic and historian from London, and Marko Stojanović, a Serbian comics theoretician, scriptwriter, and editor.



# ČAROBNA KNJIGA

Izdavačka kuća Čarobna knjiga ove godine obeležava dve decenije postojanja, kao i jedanaestu godinu bavljenja strip-izdavaštvom. U protekloj godini očuvan je ritam od oko stotinu stripskih izdanja, a matična biblioteka stripa - *Olovka, tuš i pero* - nedavno je obeležila i jubilarni petstoti naslov: *Fleš / Zagor: Sekira i munja*, prvi krossover junaka izdavačkih kuća DC i Boneli objavljen na našim prostorima.

U proteklim godinu dana Čarobna knjiga završila je objavljivanje serijala *Bluberi* i *Narednik Kirk*, a pri tom su objavljeni neki od najrespektabilnijih naslova svetskog stripa poput *Vezenja* Mardan Satrapi, celokupnog *Ugovora s Bogom* Vila Ajznera, dve knjige *Šokova budućnosti* Alana Mura i ostalih probranih britanskih autora, *Jezuite Džoa i druge priče* Huga Prata, kao i celokupnog *Bouna* Džefa Smita u pet knjiga. Zatim su nastavljeni već započeti serijali kao što je *Talični Tom*, *Ridobradi*, *Sendmen*, *Iznogud* i *Princ Valijant*. Međutim, nisu zapostavljeni ni noviji naslovi svetske produkcije. Neke od najaktuelnijih Marvelovih i DC priča našle su svoje mesto u biblioteci Čarobne knjige: *Večni* Kjerona Gilena i Esada Ribića, *Fantastična četvor-*

*ka: Pun krug Alekса Rosa, Vladavina Đavola* Čipa Zdarskog, *Betmen: Noć Mračnog Viteza...* Neki od frankofonih naslova edicije *Stari kontinent* ujedno su i među najnovijim naslovima u matičnoj zemlji. Na primer, *1629... ili jeziva priča o brodolomnicima „Džakarte”* Gzavije Dorizona i Timotea Montenja tek nedavno je objavljena u Francuskoj, isto kao *Republika lobanje* Vensana Bruža i Ronana Tuloe, *Lovci na nektar* Aleksandra Ristorčelija prema književnom predlošku Lorana Ženfora i *Prokleta hulja* Režisa Loazeala i Olivjea Pona. U tom smislu Čarobna knjiga ne prestano radi na ravnoteži novijih i starijih naslova svetskog stripa koji se predstavljaju čitaocima i doprinose opštoj stripskoj kulturi na našim prostorima.

Manga biblioteka Čarobne knjige je novina od prošle godine, a sada već broji više od 60 izdanja. *Borbeni andeo Alita* završen je sa devetim tankobonom u januaru, a *Tokijski osvetnici* i *Oštrica besmrtnika* napreduju mesečnim ritmom do kraja. U međuvremenu je u biblioteku uvršćen i planetarni hit *Čelični alhemičar* Hiromu Arakave, a Čarobna knjiga tokom ove godine završila je još nekoliko kraćih manga serijala - *Planetes* Makotoa Jukimure, *Oblik glasa* Jošitoki Oime i *Dedpul samuraj* Sanšira Kasame i Hikarua Uesugija.



## AWARD FOR THE BEST PUBLISHER OF FOREIGN COMICS EDITIONS IN SERBIA 2022-2023

The publishing house *Čarobna knjiga* (Magic Book) is celebrating two decades of existence this year, as well as its eleventh year in the field of comics publishing. In the past year, it maintained a rhythm of around one hundred comic releases, and its flagship comics library, *Olovka, tuš i pero* (Pencil, Ink, and Pen), recently reached a milestone with its 500th title: *Flash / Zagor: Axe and Thunder*, the first crossover of DC and Bonelli's characters published in our region.



Over the past year, *Čarobna knjiga* completed the publication of series *Blueberry* and *Sergeant Kirk*, while also releasing some of the most esteemed titles in the world of comics, including Marjane Satrapi's *Embroideries*, the complete *A Contract with God* by Will Eisner, two volumes of Alan Moore's *Future Shocks* and other selected works by British authors, *Jesuit Joe and Other Stories* by Hugo Pratt, as well as the complete *Bone* series by Jeff Smith in five books. They also continued ongoing series such as *Lucky Luke*, *Redbeard*, *Sandman*, *Iznogoud*, and *Prince Valiant*.

Moreover, it did not neglect newer titles from global production. Some of the most current *Marvel* and *DC* stories found their place in the library of *Čarobna knjiga*, including Kieron Gillen and Esad Ribić's *Eternals*, Alex Ross's *Fantastic Four: Full Circle*,

Chip Zdarsky's *Devil's Reign*, and *Batman: The Dark Knight*. Some of the French-language titles from the Old Continent edition are among the newest releases in the home country as well. For example, *1629, or the frightening story of the castaways of Jakarta* by Xavier Dorison and Timothée Montaigne was recently published in France, along with *Republic of the Skull* by Vincent Bruegas and Ronan Toulhoat, *Sap Hunters* by Alexandre

Ristorcelli based on Laurent Genefort's novel, and *Cursed Bastard* by Régis Loisel and Olivier Pont. In that aspect, *Čarobna knjiga* continuously works on balancing newer and older titles from the world of comics, presenting them to readers and contributing to the overall comics culture in our region.


The manga library of *Čarobna knjiga* is a new addition since last year and now counts more than 60 releases. The series *Battle Angel Alita* concluded with its ninth tankōbon in January, while *Tokyo Avengers* and *Blade of the Immortal* progress on a monthly basis. Meanwhile, the library also included the planetary hit *Fullmetal Alchemist* by Hiromu Arakawa. Throughout this year, *Čarobna knjiga* completed several shorter manga series, including *Planete* by Makoto Yukimura, *A Silent Voice* by Yoshitoki Ōima, and *Deadpool: Samurai* by Sanshiro Kasama and Hikaru Uesugi.




## SPECIJALNO PRIZNANJE ZA DOPRINOS SRPSKOM STRIPU

# DARKO PEROVIĆ

Darko Perović je srpski strip autor, rođen 1965. godine u Arandelovcu u Srbiji. Stripom je počeo da se bavi nakon što je završio Grafičku školu na Novom Beogradu, 1983. Njegova prva duga priča *Brek* nagrađena je priznanjem lista *Polet* kao najbolji jugoslovenski strip 1987. godine, a 1990. objavljen je broširani album. Dvadeset godina kasnije u izdanju kuće *Komiko* objavljena je i u tvrdom povezu, a 2018. u Francuskoj, u izdanju kuće *Inukšuk*. Na Salonu stripa u Vinkovcima 1988. godine osvojio je nagradu za scenario sa pričom od šest strana pod naslovom *Azra, Alaraph...* Jedno vreme radi na animiranim filmovima u studiju crtanog filma *FRZ Beograd*, na storibordovima, animiranim reklamama i kratkim filmovima. Godine 1989. bezuspšeno pokušava da u produkciji *Zagreb filma* napravi kratki film *Jedna zvezda za mene*. Radi ilustracije i animirane filmove za Školski program RTS-a, omladinsku štampu, plakate, naslovne strane... Godine 1991. preselio se u Španiju. Radi na kratkim pričama sa scenaristom Sanchez Abulijem, na kratkom serijalu po sopstvenom scenariju *Duboko i hladno*, na storibordovima i reklamama. Hrvatski izdavač *Libellus* je kratke priče sa Abulijem 2010. objedinio u albumu *Opake priče*, a *Inukšuk* ih je 2022. objavio u Francuskoj pod naslovom *Histoires abominables*. Sve kratke stribove nastale osamdesetih i serijal *Duboko i hladno*

2011. objavio je izdavač *Sistem komiks* u Srbiji, a 2020. *Inukšuk*, u Francuskoj, pod naslovom *Satori Bar*. Krajem 1997. godine dobio je ponudu od italijanske izdavačke kuće *Serđo Boneli Editore* za rad na serijalu *Magični Vetur* po scenariju Đanfranika Manfredija. Saradnja je nakratko bila prekinuta zbog rata u Jugoslaviji, ali je obnovljena u januaru 2000. godine epizodom *Plavi vukovi*. Do danas je potpisao sedamnaest epizoda *Magičnog Vetrta*. Za *Serđo Boneli Editore* radio je i na miniserijalima *Šangaj Devil* i *Adam Vajld*. Paralelno

sa radom za SBE, zpočinje i saradnju sa francuskim izdavačem *Soleil*. Po scenariju Novija 2010. crta album *Tajne sveske Vatikana*, sa Olivijecom Dobremelom stvara diptih *Alamo* 2011, sa Stefanom Betbederom 2014. takođe diptih *Dr Votson*. Godine 2022. u izdanju *Delkura* objavljuje prvi album serijala *Kapetan Vudu*. Živi i radi u Beogradu, u Srbiji.

## SPECIAL AWARD FOR GENERAL CONTRIBUTION TO SERBIAN COMICS

Darko Perović is a Serbian comics artist, born in 1965 in Arandjelovac, Serbia. He began his career in comics after completing Graphic School in New Belgrade in 1983. His first full-length story, *Breck*, was awarded by the magazine *Polet* as the best Yugoslavian comic in 1987. In 1990, it was published as a brochure album. Twenty years later, it was reissued in hardcover by Comico, and in 2018, it was published in France by *Inukshuk*. At the Vinkovci Comic Festival in 1988, he won an award for the script of a six-page story titled *Azra, Alaraph...* He worked on animated films at the animation studio of the Center of Film Working Communities Belgrade, also creating storyboards, animated commercials, and short films. In 1989, he unsuccessfully attempted to produce a short film titled *Jedna zvezda za mene* (A Star for Me) with *Zagreb Film*. He worked on illustrations and animated films for the State Television School Program, youth press, posters, and cover art. In 1991, he moved to Spain. He collaborated with scriptwriter Sánchez Abulí on short stories, as well as on a short series titled *Duboko i hladno* (Deep and Cold) based on his own script, and also on storyboards and commercials. Croatian publisher *Libel-*

*lus* compiled his short stories with Abulí in 2010 in a book titled *Opake priče* (Abominable Stories), and *Inukshuk* published them in France in 2022 under the title *Histoires abominables*. All the short comics from the 1980s and the series *Duboko i hladno* were published by *System Comics* in Serbia in 2011, and *Inukshuk* released them in France in 2020 under the title *Satiny Bar*. In late 1997, he received an offer from the Italian publishing house *Sergio Bonelli Editore* to work on the series *Mágico Vento* (The Magic Wind) with a script by Gianfranco Manfredi. The collaboration was briefly interrupted due to the war in Yugoslavia but resumed in January 2000 with the episode *Blue Wolves*. To date, he has contributed to seventeen episodes of the series. He also worked on the miniseries *Shanghai Devil* and *Adam Wild* for *Sergio Bonelli Editore*. Simultaneously, he began collaborating with the French publisher *Soleil*. Based on a script by Novy, he illustrated the album *The Secrets of Vatican Files*. He created the two-volume *Alamo* with Olivier Dobremel in 2011 and the two-volume *Dr. Watson* with Stéphane Betbeder in 2014. In 2022, he published the first volume of the series *Captain Voodoo* for *Delcourt*. He lives and works in Belgrade.

Bàrbara Alca, Marta Cartu, Genie Espinosa, Ana Galvañ, Nadia Hafid, Conxita Herreiro, María Medem, Miriampersand i Roberta Vázquez predstavljaju konstelaciju kreativnih univerzuma sjedinjenih u ovu izložbu. Devet umetnica koje eksperimentišu stilovima i jezicima, ruše konvencije stripa i dele kritički pogled na svet, oscilirajući između poetskog i humornog.



Izložba *Grafička konstelacija* predstavlja raznolikost jezika, estetskih registara i kulturnih referenci ovih devet kreatorki koje svojom upotrebotom boja, grafike, stilističke i narativne eksperimentacije, izazivaju hegeemonijsku estetiku stripa.

U svom radu, ovih devet umetnica bacaju sumnjičav pogled na teme milenijumske egzistencije, poput ekonomskih i radnih nesigurnosti, nestanka stabilnosti, naše ambivalentnosti prema tehnologiji, snage sestrinstva i tečnog stanja ljubavnih odnosa u eri Tinder-a.

Izložba takođe predstavlja poziv da se otkrije kako je mreža samizdat sajmova, malih izdavačkih kuća i štamparija učvrstila alternativnu scenu na kojoj se ovih devet umetnica kreću i uče. Ona takođe ističe na koji način stripski jezik može da izade iz papira i oživi u drugim umetničkim medijima.

Priredena od strane Monserat Terones, *Grafička konstelacija*, bila je otvorena od 2. decembra 2022. do 18. juna 2023. godine u CCCB (Centar za savremenu kulturu Barselone). Izložba je nastojala da dovede u pitanje kanonske forme koje su do sada korisene u stripskim izložbama, pokušavajući da poštuje kako poreklo, tako i narativnu dimenziju medija. Imala je za cilj da ponudi inovativnu perspektivu na strip, dopuštajući strip-kaišima i njihovim likovima da preuzmu prostor izložbe.

Devet umetnica bile su pozvane da zamisle nove načine invazije muzejskog prostora kroz maštovita rešenja zasnovana na suštini stripa kao sekvencijalnog narativa putem likovne imaginacije u devet instalacija koje su stvorene upravo za tu priliku. Mediji i publika su ovaj projekat pozdravili kao pravu inovativnu igru.

Izložba koja sada stiže u Beograd putujući je arhiv materijala prikazanih u Barseloni, prenosna uspomena na ambiciozan projekt koji je slavio izvanredan trenutak kreativnosti devet sjajnih talenata.

Bàrbara Alca, Marta Cartu, Genie Espinosa, Ana Galvañ, Nadia Hafid, Conxita Herrero, María Medem, Miriampersand and Roberta Vázquez make up the constellation of creative universes that is this exhibition. Nine artists who experiment with styles and languages, who break with comic-book conventions, and share a critical view of the world, that oscillates between the poetic and

al experience, such as economic and job insecurity, the disappearance of stability, our ambivalence towards technology, the force of sisterhood and the liquid condition of love relationships in the Tinder era.

The exhibition is also an invitation to discover how a network of self-publishing fairs, small publishing houses and printers have consolidated the alternative scene on which these nine artists move and learn. And it highlights how comic language can step off the paper and come to life in other artistic media.

Curated by Montserrat Terrones, *Graphic Constellation*, open from 2 December 2022 to 18 June 2023 at CCCB (Centre de Cultura Contemporània de Barcelona), wanted to question the canonical forms used until now in comic exhibitions, trying to respect both the popular origin and the narrative dimension of the medium. The exhibition aimed to offer an innovative perspective on comics, letting the strips and their characters take over the exhibition space.

The nine artists were invited to imagine new ways of invading the museum space with imaginative solutions based on the essence of the comic as a sequential narrative through graphic imagination in nine installations created expressly for the occasion. The press and the public hailed the proposal as a true game-changing project.

The exhibition now presented in Belgrade, is a traveling archive of the materials shown in Barcelona, a portable memory of an ambitious project that celebrated the prodigious creative moment of a constellation of nine radiant talents.

Genie Espinosa je ilustratorka, strip autorka i muralistkinja iz Barselone. Koristeći čisto digitalne alate i četkicu, radi za razne publikacije (*Das Magazin, Cajt, Tajm Aut, Diari Ara, Vajs, Vajred, Refineri29*) i klijente poput Epla, Sonija, Najki, Spotifaja, Vitransfера i Klarne. Njen rad odlikuju jake boje, preuveličane perspektive i izuzetno veliki, nenormativni likovi u njenim radovima koji ne žale prostora. Njene ilustracije su prijatne i nežne na prvi pogled, ali ponekad imaju tamnu pozadinu i gotovo uvek dvostruko značenje. Alternating between the purely digital and the paintbrush, she works both for editorial publications (*Das Magazine, Die Zeit, Time Out, Diari Ara, Vice, Wired, Refinery29...*) and a variety of clients such as Apple, Sony, Nike, Spotify, WeTransfer and Klarna. Her work is characterized by a range of strong colours, exaggerated perspectives and excessively large, non-normative characters who are unapologetic for the space they take up in her work. Her illustrations are pleasant and gentle in appearance, but sometimes have a dark background and, almost always, a double meaning. Her latest work includes the cover of “MAFIOSA”, a single by singer Nathy Peluso, and the launch of her first graphic novel *HOOPS* (Sapristi, March 2021), where, in a dystopian future, three friends from the suburbs accidentally fall into an interdimensional hole from which they cannot escape without first discovering the secrets of this new place and battling with their own monsters. This graphic novel won her the Miguel Gallardo Award for the Best New Writer at the 40th COMIC BCN SALON and the RNE ÓJO CRÍTICO Comic Prize 2021. She coordinates the fanzine *RARAS* (2019) and *MUY RARAS* (2020), in which she self-publishes a selection of artists, illustrators and writers to promote multidisciplinary female talent (one of the Best Comics of 2020 according to *The Comics Journal*).






This exhibition aims to present the richness and versatility of their artistic achievements. It also shows how their wider artistic expressions influence their comics art.



We hope this exhibition will contribute to a better appreciation of comics art and artists within the wider art world.















Aleksandar Zograff (Pančevo, 1964) objavio je grafičke romane u SAD, Velikoj Britaniji, Italiji, Francuskoj, Japanu... Radi ilustracije, knjiške ilustracije, filmove, sarađuje sa italijanskim bendovima (*Cvet Bolge*, *Džet Set Rodžer*) za koje kreira omotnice izdanja i crta na bini dok oni sviraju.

Aleksandar Zograff (Pančevo, 1964) has published his graphic novels in The US, Great Britain, Italy, France, Japan and more. He works on illustrations, book illustrations, films, collaborates with Italian bands (*Fior delle bolge*, *Jet Set Roger*) by producing album covers and draws on stage while they perform.

## 145 GODINA OD OSNIVANJA ČASOPISA *ZMAJ I STARMALI*

U katalogu 16. salona stripa 2018. detaljnije smo pisali o nekim od ovih jubileja, pa i o okolnostima u kojima su se Srbi borili za svoju kulturu u južnom delu Srbije pod Turskom, gde su - pored bolnica, škola i drugih institucija - duže od 400 godina bile zabranjene i štamparije. (...) Bilo je mnogo srpskih urednika i kulturnih poslenika, ali najpoznatiji je ostao Jovan Jovanović, koji je po svom listu *Zmaj* dobio doživotni

nadimak. Osnovao je i listove *Neven* (izlazio 1880-1908), *Starmali* i još mnoge. Prvi broj urednički je završen 1878. ali je zbog „administrativnih“ problema „u promet“ pušten tek 1879. Izlazio je do 1888. I u *Starmalom* i u *Nevenu* Zmaj je objavio mnogo kratkih (pra)stripova, ne samo srpskih umetnika, već i čeških, nemačkih i mađarskih, a i sam

je crtao. Koristio je i već gotova klišea iz Velike Britanije. Sličnu sudbinu oko odobrenja austrijske cenzure za distribuciju




je imao i *Golub*, somborski „list za srpsku mladež“, koji je izašao tek 11. januara 1879. Punih 28 godina (1879 - 1906) uređivao ga je učitelj i upravitelj somborske Srpske više devojačke škole Jovan Blagojević.

## 145 YEARS SINCE THE FOUNDING OF THE MAGAZINES *ZMAJ* AND *STARMALI*

In the catalog of the 16th Festival in 2018, we wrote in more detail about some of these anniversaries, also describing the circumstances in which the Serbs fought for their culture in the southern part of Serbia under Ottoman rule, where, alongside hospitals, schools, and other institutions, printing presses were banned for over 400 years. (...) There were many Serbian ed-

itors and cultural workers, but the most famous among them was Jovan Jovanović, who earned a lifelong nickname based on his magazine *Zmaj* (“Dragon”). He also founded the magazines *Neven* (published from 1880 to 1908), *Starmali* (“Precocious”) and many others. The first issue was completed by the editorial team in 1878, but due to “administrative” problems, it was released in circulation only in 1879. It was published until 1888. In both *Starmali* and *Neven*, Zmaj published many short (pre)comics, not only by Serbian but also by Czech, German, and Hungarian artists, and he also drew comics himself. He also used pre-made plates from Great Britain. A similar fate regarding approval from Austrian censorship for distribution was faced by *Golub*, a newspaper for Serbian youth in Sombor, which was only released on January 11, 1879. It was edited for a full 28 years (1879-1906) by Jovan Blagojević, a teacher and administrator of the *Serbian Girls’ School* in Sombor.



## 85 GODINA OD MEĐURATNOG BIG BENGA STRIPSKIH ČASOPISA

U katalogu 16. salona stripa 2018. detaljno smo pisali o 1938. kao godini u kojoj je između dva svetska rata pokrenuto najviše srpskih stripских časopisa, većinom sa američkim, ali i domaćim stripovima. Uz ranije postojeće, pokretane i gašene, *Strip*, *Mika Miš*, *Mikijeve novine*, *Crtani film*, *Zabavnik*, *Crveni vrabac*, *Mali zabavnik Mika Miš*, *Veseli zabavnik* i *Truba*, popisali smo i sadržaje magazina *Buffalo Bill*, *Paja Patak*, *Tarcan*... Gužva na tržištu bila je takva da je došlo i do prvog istorijskog autorskog sudskog strip-skog spora Ivana Zrnića i kompanije Aleksandra Ivkovića oko intelektualne svojine, autorskih i izdavačkih prava na strip *Fantom* Leeja Falka i Rayja Moorea, u nesudrenom i povučenom magazinu *Novi Tarcan*, preimenovanom u *Truba*, pa u *Truba Fantom*. Konkurenциju moćne kompanije Ivkovića sa matičnim časopisom *Mika Miš* preživeo je do 1939. samo časopis *Paja Patak* vlasnika Đurađa M. Jeličića. No, tada se glavni urednik *Mike Miš*, Milutin Ignjačević, odvojio i osnovao svoj časopis *Mikijevo carstvo*, a velika novinska kuća *Politika* startovala *Politikin zabavnik* (koji izlazi i danas) i Ivković je konačno dobio moćne suparnike. No, to je tema teksta o 1939. za naredni Salon.

## 85 YEARS SINCE THE INTERWAR BIG BANG OF COMICS MAGAZINES

In the catalog of the 16th Comics Festival in 2018, we wrote in detail about 1938 as the year when the most Serbian comics magazines were launched in the Interwar period, mostly featuring American but also domestic comics. In addition to the existing, started and discontinued ones, such as *Strip*, *Mika Miš*, *Mikijeve novine*, *Crtani film*, *Zabavnik*, *Crveni vrabac*, *Mali zabavnik Mika Miš*, *Veseli zabavnik*, and *Truba*, we listed the contents of magazines *Buffalo Bill*, *Paja Patak*, *Tarcan*... The market was so crowded that it even led to the first historical copyright lawsuit between Ivan Zrnić and Aleksandar




Ivković's company regarding the intellectual property, authorship, and publishing rights of the comics *Phantom* by Lee Falk and Ray Moore, in the ill-fated and withdrawn magazine *Novi Tarcan*, renamed to *Truba*, and then to *Truba Phantom*. The competition from Ivković's powerful company with its flagship magazine *Mika Miš* was, until 1939, only survived by *Paja Patak*, owned by Đurađ M. Jeličić. However, at that time, the editor-in-chief of *Mika Miš*, Milutin Ignjačević, separated and established his own magazine *Mikijevo carstvo*, and the major newspaper house *Politika* launched *Politikin zabavnik* (which is still in publication today), giving Ivković formidable rivals. But that is the subject of the text on 1939 for the next festival.

## 80 GODINA ČASOPISA *MALI ZABAVNIK*

Nacistička Nemačka je aprila 1941. okupirala Srbiju, podelila je i neke delove današnje Srbije prepustila svojim saveznicima Mađarskoj, Bugarskoj i Hrvatskoj. U Srbiji su gotovo svi dotadašnji listovi prestali da izlaze. Pojavili su se novi. No, tek 1. decembra 1943. izašao je prvi broj *Malog zabavnika*. Imao je 16 strana (četiri u dve boje), od čega su na šest bili stripovi, a na ostalima tekstovi. Broj stripova je rastao, pa se, na primer, u br. 14 stripovi zauzeli čak 10 stranica. Vlasnik i glavni urednik bio je Dragoljub Prljinčević. Autori nekih vrlo dobrih stripova (SF, istorijski, avanturički, humoristički...) bili

su Dragan Kalmarević, Dragan Savić, Konstantin Kuznjecov, Vsevolod Guljević, Veljko Kockar, Slavko Janić, Bruno Maskareli, Vladimir - Vlada Savić... Posle povlačenja nacista iz Beograda i Srbije, oktobra 1944. godine, i dolaska Crvene armije i komunističkih partizana, časopis je, kao crno-beli, 24. septembra 1944. ugašen brojem 27, a neki urednici i saradnici ovog zabavnog časopisa su streljani, emigrirali su, oduzeta su im građanska prava i imovina, ili su završili na dugogodišnjim robijama. Na primer, Kuznjecov je sa Nemcima otišao na Zapad i umro u SAD, a ilustrator, karikaturista i stripar Kockar je od Prekog vojnog suda osuđen i po kratkom postupku streljan. O Kockaru je 2017. Aleksandar Zograf snimio nagradjivani dokumentarni film *Poslednja avantura Kaktus Bate*.



## 80 YEARS OF *MALI ZABAVNIK* MAGAZINE

Nazi Germany occupied Serbia in April 1941, dividing it and relinquishing some parts to their allies Hungary, Bulgaria and Croatia.

Almost all existing newspapers in Serbia ceased publication, giving way to new ones. However, it wasn't until December 1, 1943, that the first issue of *Mali zabavnik* (Little Entertainer) was released. It consisted of 16 pages (four in two colors), with six pages dedicated to comics and the rest to texts. The number of comics pages increased over time, with issue 14 featuring as many as 10 of them. The owner and chief editor was Dragoljub Prljinčević.

Some notable authors of excellent comics (science fiction, historical, adventure, humor, etc.) included Dragan Kalmarević, Dragan Savić, Konstantin Kuznetsov, Vsevolod Gulyevich, Veljko Kockar, Slavko Janić, Bruno Mascarelli, and Vladimir Vlada Savić. After the Nazis withdrew from Belgrade and Serbia in October 1944, and with the arrival of the Red Army and communist partisans, the magazine ceased publication on September 24, 1944, with issue 27 in black and white. Some editors and contributors of this entertainment magazine were executed, forced into emigration, had their civil rights and property confiscated, or endured lengthy imprisonments. For instance, Kuznetsov went west with the Germans and died in the USA, while illustrator, caricaturist, and comics artist Kockar was quickly convicted by a military court and executed. In 2017, Aleksandar Zograf made an award-winning documentary film titled *Poslednja avantura Kaktus Bate* (The Last Adventure of Cactus Kid) about Kockar.

## 70 GODINA OD POSLERATNOG BIG BENGA STRIPSKIH ČASOPISA

Ono što je 1938. godina bila za Srbiju po broju novopokrenutih časopisa specijalizovanih za strip, ili periodike sa velikom zastupljeničću različitih stripova, to je posle Drugog svetskog rata bila 1953. Ogranak tržišni uspeh nedeljnika *Politikin zabavnik* koji je obnovljen januara 1952. godine (pre rata postojao 1939 - 1941, a izlazi i danas) dao je ideju mnogima. U do tada najvećim strip-skim centrima pokrenuti su *Panorama*, *Panorama strip* i *Mikijeve novine* kod izdavača Dnevnik iz Novog Sada, kao i *Dugin magazin*, *Dugin zabavnik Robinzon* i *Strip zabavnik Robinzon* izdavača *NIP Duga* (oba Robinzona očigledno svojim naslovom emotivno diskretno „podsećaju“ publiku na časopis *Robinzon* iz 1936. urednika Milutina Ignjačevića i na kuću Aleksandra Ivkovića), te *Crtani magazin* NIP *Omladina*, oba iz Beograda. Plus, mnoštvo zasebnih strip-skih svesaka izdavača: *NIP Mladi borac* (komunistička omladina), *NIP Radnik* (komunističko-radnička štampa), IP *Dečja štampa* (za najmlađi komunistički podmladak „pionire“)... Sadržaje su kreirali inostrani i srpski autori. Na primer, u *Duginom magazinu* objavljeni su: *King, junak konjičke policije*, ali ne Charlesa Flandersa već upravo iz prve godine kada je crtanje preuzeo Jim Garry (oktobar 1939), zatim iz 1952. svež *Brik Bradford Klenrena Greja* (*Brick Bradford*, Clarence Gray, 1952), *Minjon Branka Vidića* i *Nikole Navojeva*, *Diznijev Miki i morski vuk*, *Tarzan*, *Tim Taylor*, *David Koperfild* Alexis Ranhnera, tek 1952. kreiran *Neustrašivi kauboј Roj Rodžers*, pa *Kralj i strelac...*



## 70 YEARS SINCE THE AFTERWAR BIG BANG OF COMICS MAGAZINES

What the year of 1938 was for Serbia in terms of the number of newly launched magazines specialized in comics or periodicals with a significant representation of different comics, the year of 1953 became after World War II. The tremendous market success of the weekly magazine *Politikin zabavnik* (Politika's Entertainer), which was relaunched in January 1952 (having existed before the war from 1939 to 1941 and still being published today), inspired many others. In the previously established major comics centers, publications such as *Panorama*, *Panorama strip*, and *Mikijeve novine* (Mickey's Newspaper) were launched by the publisher Dnevnik from Novi Sad, along with *Dugin magazine* (Duga's Magazine) *Dugin zabavnik Robinzon* (Duga's Entertainer Robinson) and *Strip zabavnik Robinzon* (Comics Entertainer Robinson) by the publisher *NIP Duga* (both Robinzon titles subtly “reminiscent” of the 1936 magazine Robinzon edited by Milutin Ignjačević and the publishing house of Aleksandar Ivković). Additionally, *Crtani magazin* by the publisher *NIP Omladina*, and numerous separate comics issues were released, including those by *NIP Mladi borac* (communist youth), *NIP Radnik* (communist-worker press), and *IP Dečja štampa* (for the youngest communist youth “pioneers”) from Belgrade. The content was created by foreign and Serbian authors. For example, *Dugin magazin* featured *King of the Royal Mounted*, but not by Charles Flanders, rather from the first year when Jim Garry took over the art (October 1939). It also included the fresh addition of *Brick Bradford* by Clarence Gray (1952), *Minyon* by Branko Vidić and Nikola Navoev, Disney's *Mickey and the Sea Wolf*, *Tarzan*, *Tim Tyler's Luck*, *David Copperfield* by Alexis Ranhner, the newly created *Fearless Cowboy Roy Rogers* (1952), and the *King and Archer...*


U broju pet lista za najmlađe *Zeka*, 5. novembra 1973. godine, prvi put se pojavio dečji humoristički strip *Zuzuko* Zdravka Zupana (1950 - 2015). Potom, *Zuzuko* je povremeno izlazio u listovima: *Zeka*, *YU strip*, *Male novine*, *Letnji* i *Zimski zabavnik Male novine*, *Vesela sveska*, *Balon*, *Dečje novine*, *Totem*, *Suncokret*, *Munja strip*... Od kraja 2002. godine bio je stalni sadržaj u dečjem enigmatskom zabavniku *Munja*. Redovno je izlazio i u dečjem listu *Bijela pčela* koji u Hrvatskoj izdaje *Srpsko društvo Prosvjeta*. *Zuzuko* je pretežno rađen u geg-tablama, izuzev nekoliko kraćih epizoda rađenih od dve do četiri strane. Po red Zupana, na pisanju scenarija učestvovali su Nikola Maslovara i Vasa Pavković. Zupan, inače vodeći istoričar srpskog i ex-YU stripa, 1988. pokrenuo je i odličan sopstveni strip-ski časopis *Cepelin*. Nažalost, ubrzana ekonomska kriza i građanski ratovi u SFRJ do 1991. omogućili su izlaska samo tri magazinska broja sa tvrdim koricama i jednog na velikom novinskom formatu. Sadržali su tekstove o stripu, kao i prevedene i domaće radove.



**50 YEARS SINCE THE FIRST  
APPEARANCE OF THE CHILDREN'S  
MAGAZINE *ZUZUKO* AND  
35 YEARS SINCE THE LAUNCH OF  
COMICS MAGAZINE *ZEPPELIN***

In issue five of the children's magazine *Zeka*, on November 5, 1973, the children's humorous comic strip *Zuzuko* by Zdravko Zupan (1950-2015) made its first appearance. Subsequently, *Zuzuko* occasionally appeared in magazines such as *Zeka*, *YU strip*, *Male novine*, *Letnji* and *Zimski zabavnik Male novine*, *Vesela sveska*, *Baloon*, *Dečje novine*, *Totem*, *Suncokret*, *Munja strip*... Since the end of 2002, it has been a regular feature in the children's puzzle magazine *Munja* (Flash). It also regularly appeared in the children's magazine *Bijela pčela* (The White Bee) published by the Serbian Cultural Society *Prosvjeta* in Croatia. *Zuzuko* was primarily created in gag

panels, with a few shorter episodes ranging from two to four pages. In addition to Zupan, Nikola Maslovara and Vasa Pavković also participated in writing the scripts. Zupan, a leading historian of Serbian and ex-Yugoslav comics, launched an excellent comics magazine called *Zeppelin* in 1988. Unfortunately, the accelerated economic crisis and civil wars in Yugoslavia until 1991 allowed for the release of only three magazine issues with hard covers and one in a large newspaper format. They contained articles about comics as well as translated and domestic works.



## **45 GODINA OD PRVE IZLOŽBE MLADI YU STRIP LISTA MLADOST U SKC-u 1978.**

Prvi od tri jugoslovenska konkursa za strip, koje je na inicijativu novinara Momira Tomića raspisao i organizovao savezni državni omladinski list *Mladost* iz Beograda, završen je dodelom prve nagrade Mirku Iliću. I naredne dve godine, 1979. i 1980, održani su konkursi, a samo je ovaj imao katalog. Sve izložbe postavljene su u foajeu SKC-a na spratu, gde je na našim Salonima berza stripova. Naredni jugoslovenski stripski konkursi *Mladosti* raspisani su tek 1988. i 1989. godine.

## **45 YEARS SINCE THE FIRST EXHIBITION OF *MLADI YU STRIP* OF MAGAZINE *MLADOST* IN THE STUDENT CULTURAL CENTER IN 1978**

The first of three Yugoslav comics contests, initiated by journalist Momir Tomić and organized by the federal youth magazine *Mladost* from Belgrade, concluded with the awarding of the first prize to Mirko Ilić. In the following two years, 1979 and 1980, additional contests were held, but only the first one had a catalog. All exhibitions were set up in the Student Cultural Center foyer on the upper floor, where the comics marketplace is held during our festival. The next Yugoslav comics contests by *Mladost* were not announced until 1988 and 1989.

## **25 GODINA INTERNETSKOG ČASOPISA *STRIP VESTI***

Na e-adrese nas dvadesetoro, 25. decembra 1998. godine, uz obećanje „da će taj broj do Nove godine biti veći od 50“, neočekivano je stigao mejl. Napisao nam ga je Zlatko Milenković (Novi Sad, 1969), koga sam do tada znao samo po njegovim stripovima, a i godinama potom nisam ga lično upoznao, čak ni kada sam povodom jubilarnog 150. broja napisao tekst (eno ga i danas u rubrici *SpecArhiva* na sajtu <http://www.stripvesti.com>) u počast ovog, svake hvale prvog srpskog striporskog internet časopisa kojeg nam je uporno (ni danas ne znam kako je uspevao!) jednom nedeljno mejlovima slao od petka 1. januara 1999, čak i za vreme NATO bombardovanja Srbije (od marta do juna), sve do broja 402. od 2. marta 2007. Ogroman broj rubrika, kolumni, komentara, polemika, najava, konkursa, kritika, promocija... Menjao je nekoliko puta i dizajn. Onda je 15. marta 2007. napisao: „*Strip vesti* su mrtve - živele *Strip vesti!*“, pa je napustio nedeljno slanje formiranih brojeva i postavio sajt koji je svakodnevno ažurirao...

## **25 YEARS OF THE *STRIP VESTI* (COMICS NEWS) ONLINE MAGAZINE**

On December 25, 1998, an unexpected email arrived at the addresses of twenty of us. The email came with a promise “that the issues will be over 50 by New Year.” It was written by Zlatko Milenković (Novi Sad, 1969), whom I knew only through his comics. Even in the years that followed, I never personally met him, not even when I wrote an article for the commemorative 150th issue (which is still available today in the SpecArchive section on the website <http://www.stripvesti.com>). The article was written in honor of this highly praised first Serbian comics internet magazine. Zlatko persistently (I still don’t know how he managed!) sent us weekly emails every Friday from January 1, 1999, even during the NATO bombing of Serbia (from March to June), until issue 402 on March 2, 2007. The magazine had a tremendous number of columns, commentaries, discussions, announcements, contests, critiques, promotions... Zlatko changed the design several times. Then, on March 15, 2007, he wrote: “Comics news is dead - long live Comics news!” and discontinued the weekly sending of formatted issues. Instead, he set up a website that he updated daily...

## 15 GODINA ČASOPISA STRIPOLIS

Akademski slikar, magistar slikarstva Branko Đukić već deceniju je najjača i najaktivnija spona između tzv. čiste/prave likovne umetnosti i stripa. Rođen je u Zrenjaninu 1966. gde živi i radi i danas. Posle važnog izdanja *Zrenjaninski strip almanah*, kojeg je uredio, i uspeha samostalne beogradske izložbe slika inspirisane stripom, 2008. godine odlučio je da napravi nekakav periodični zbornik. No, on se, posle 14 godina i isto toliko brojeva od kojih nijedan nije imao manje od 120 vrlo dobro odštampanih stranica na velikom formatu i izvanrednoj hartiji, pretvorio u redovan časopis. Verno su reproducovani i stripovi koji su originalno u koloru i oni koji su crno-beli. Đukić kaže: „Časopis *Stripolis* formiran je sa željom da se jedan ovakav oblik verbo-vizuelnog izražavanja pomeri sa ivice ka središtu umetničkog dešavanja i tako razbije stereotip o ovom mediju. Moja prvobitna namera bila je da u njemu bude samo srpski strip, ali su se ponudili da, bez honorara, objavljuju autori iz SAD, Kine, Kanade, Irana, Argentine, Meksika, cele Evrope... gotovo iz svih krajeva sveta.“ Kulturni centar Zrenjanina je stalna podrška ovom obliku neprofitne internacionalne stripske solidarnosti. Na ovogodišnjem Salonu u SKC-u predstaviće i 15. broj. Dakle, oko 2.000 stranica najneobičnijih, a izuzetnih svetskih stripova!



## 15 YEARS OF STRIPOLIS MAGAZINE

Branko Đukić, an academic painter and Master of Fine Arts, has been the leading force bridging the worlds of “pure/fine art” and comics for the past decade. Born in Zrenjanin in 1966, he continues to reside and work there today. Following the significant release of the *Zrenjanin Comics Almanac*, which he edited, and the success of his solo exhibition in Belgrade showcasing comics-inspired paintings, he embarked on the creation of a periodic anthology in 2008. However, over the course of 14 years and an equal number of issues, each comprising a minimum of 120 carefully printed pages in a large format with exceptional paper quality, it has transformed into a full-fledged magazine. The magazine faithfully reproduces both color and black-and-white comics. Đukić explains, “*Stripolis* magazine was conceived with the intention of elevating this form of verbal-visual expression from the periphery to the center of artistic events, thereby shattering the stereotypes surrounding the medium. Although my initial plan was to exclusively feature Serbian comics, authors from the United States, China, Canada, Iran, Argentina, Mexico, and throughout Europe offered their contributions without compensation... hailing from nearly every corner of the world.” The Cultural Center of Zrenjanin continuously supports this non-profit, international comics solidarity initiative. The 15th issue will be showcased at this year’s Festival in the Student Cultural Center (SKC). Thus, approximately 2,000 pages of extraordinary and remarkable global comics are available for readers to explore!
